

### 1. Scientific consensus tells us that human activities are warming the planet.

- The earth has **warmed roughly 1.5 degrees Fahrenheit** since beginning of the industrial revolution. Two thirds of that warming has occurred in the past few decades.
- Warming is caused by emissions from fossil fuels and animal agriculture, and exacerbated by deforestation, among other **human activities**.

### 2. The climate crisis threatens the collapse of civilization.

- Seemingly small global temperature increases are already having huge impacts, including **intensified drought, flooding, and severe weather**.
- Climate change is already contributing to global food price shocks and will continue to negatively impact the global food supply as warming accelerates.
- **Past civilizations have collapsed under the weight of mass agricultural failure.** The culprit? Natural climate changes, which unfolded significantly more slowly and gradually than contemporary, man-made climate change.
- We are **already seeing** state failure and the collapse of civilization in some areas, such as in Syria, where drought triggered a devastating civil war.

### 3. We must act immediately and decisively.

- There is a **6.6 to 30.7-year lag** between carbon dioxide emissions and the consequent maximum warming effect.
- **We have released roughly half the greenhouse gases emitted in human history over the past thirty years.** We're only starting to feel those effects now.
- Tipping points occur when irreversible feedback loops are triggered, and warming accelerates even without human emissions of fossil fuels.
- That's why we need to both proactively adapt to this warming and mitigate it, by **reducing net emissions to zero at wartime speed and removing excess greenhouse gases from the air until a safe climate is restored.** Failing such an intervention, the earth's climate could shift into a state hostile to humanity — and even life itself — for many thousands of years.

### 4. There is hope, if we mobilize!

- We have the technology available now to drastically decrease emissions and build a post-carbon America. **All we need is the political will.**
- It is a moral imperative not to give up.
